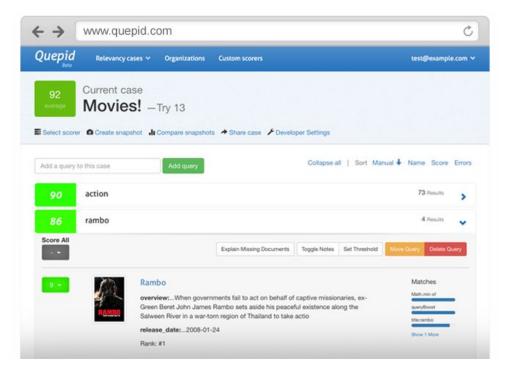



A Brief History of Quepid



- Created by Doug Turnbull in 2012
- First <u>public mention</u> of Quepid Oct 2013
- Quepid SaaS launched Nov 2015
- <u>Containerized</u> in early 2016
- <u>nDCG</u> added in Feb 2018
- Open sourced in July 2019
- <u>9 Releases</u> in 2020
